This procedure details removing broken **BigBand fans** from existing fan trays & replacing them with **NEW TAG fans (PN # TF-BIGBND-01)**.

- 1. Follow standard procedures to remove the BigBand fan tray from the SDV MUX location.
- 2. Place the fan tray onto a flat work surface.



- **3.** Remove the (2) nuts & washers attaching the cover shield to the BigBand fan tray.
- **4.** Remove the (4) screws & washers attaching the cover shield & the existing fans to the fan tray.






**8.** Carefully cut off the tie wraps from any wires connected to the fans.



- **9.** Follow the directions below to remove the wires from the terminal block that are connected to the old fans.
  - <u>Note:</u> BigBand Fan Trays can have terminal blocks <u>WITH</u> or <u>WITHOUT TABS</u>.

Tabs make the removal & installation of wires easier, but they are not needed.




### 9a. WIRES ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE TERMINAL BLOCK \* (SEE THE NOTE BELOW FIRST)


Firmly press a small screwdriver on the tabs (or in the holes) on the front of the terminal block & remove the wires (1 Blue, 1 Red & 1 Black) from the corresponding slots.

\* <u>Note:</u> DO NOT remove the thicker Yellow (3), Red (1) & Black (1) Wires that are connected to the right side of the terminal block.

### 9b. WIRES ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE TERMINAL BLOCK

Firmly insert a small screwdriver into the holes (or press on the tabs) on the front of the terminal block & remove the wires (2 Blue, 2 Red & 2 Black) from the corresponding slots.




#### Take off the old fans & place the new TAG fans (PN # TF-BIGBND-01)\* onto the fan tray as shown.

\*<u>Note:</u> The label with the TAG model number should point down towards the fan tray.







**12.** Secure the fan wires in place with new tie wraps as shown.




**14.** If the previous fans had screw guides, put them back into place on the new TAG fans. *(4 screw guides for each fan)*

- **16.** Place guard grills from the old fans over the cover shield. *(middle & right fan)*
- **17.** Insert the screws & washers from the old fans through the guard grill & cover shield as shown. (middle & right fan)


**<u>Note:</u>** The cover shield goes under the front holes of the guard grills on the middle & right fan.


**18.** Place the remaining guard grill onto the fan on the left side of the fan tray.

- **20.** Place the (2) nuts & washers on the front of the cover shield.
